Subject: UW-Madison Campus Institutional District Master Plan - Informational Meetings to City of Madison

All,

An update on the UW-Madison Campus Master Plan approval process! As the final piece of the 2015 Campus Master Plan, the University will be requesting the City of Madison to formally adopt a Campus Institutional (CI) District Master Plan as an integral part of the zoning code for the campus areas within the campus development project boundary.

We are planning a couple informational meetings at both the Plan Commission (Monday, March 6, 2017) and Urban Design Commission (Wednesday, March 8, 2017) next week to begin this submittal process. Both of these presentations will be the same and are open to the public. A similar presentation will also be presented at the Joint (West & Southeast) Campus Area Committees as indicated in the schedule below. These meetings are also open to the public. We are currently anticipating an official Land Use Application submittal to the City on April 5, 2017 with an anticipated city approval sometime in July, 2017.

The Campus Institutional district in Section 28.097 of the Zoning Code was established to recognize the City’s major educational and medical institutions as important activity centers and traffic generators, accommodate the growth and development needs of these institutions, and coordinate the master plans of these institutions with the City’s plans, policies, and zoning standards. The Plan Commission is the lead agency with final approval from the Common Council. The Urban Design Commission is required under section 28.097(7)(a) to approve the building design review standards and guidelines, review procedures, categories of membership, and the language of any deed or plat restriction to implement the master plan.
